**THE KAJIADO COUNTY CROP AGRICULTURE BILL, 2020**

**A Bill for**

**AN ACT of the County Assembly of Kajiado to establish an efficient legal and institutional framework for development and regulation of crop agriculture and for connected and incidental purposes**

**ENACTED** by the County Assembly of Kajiado as follows—

**PART I— PRELIMINARY**

**Short title and commencement**

1 This Act may be cited as the Crop Agriculture Act, 2020 and shall come into operation twenty one days after signing into law by the Governor.

**Objectives of the Act**

2. (1) The overriding objective object of this Act is to provide a comprehensive, harmonized, efficient and effective legal and regulatory framework for development and regulation of crop agriculture in Kajiado County.

(2) All County Government agencies, public servants and bodies charged with development and regulation of crop agriculture shall at all times have due regard to, and observe, the overriding objective of this Act as set out in subsection (1).

(3) Whenever there is a conflict between this Act and any other written law, having a bearing on achievement of the overriding objective of this Act, the provisions of this Act shall prevail.

**Interpretation**

3 In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires—

“Agriculture” includes—

- (a) Sugar, maize, potato, fruit, vegetable, flower and seed farming;
- (b) dairy farming, bee keeping, breeding and keeping of livestock;
- (c) Conservation and keeping of game animals, game birds, and aquatic animals;
- (d) Game ranching and game cropping;
- (e) The use of the land for grazing, market gardening, or for nursery grounds;
- (f) Agro-forestry; and
